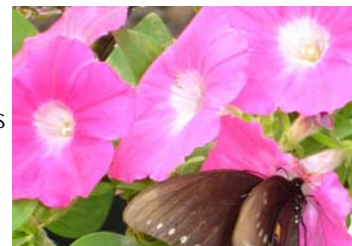
Westfield Memorial Library Presents a MothUP Storytelling Event
